### **Membership Renewals Due**

Be sure your credit union has renewed its annual membership in NACUC. Invoices were emailed to the billing contact at your credit union last month. If you have not renewed, please contact <a href="macuc@nacuc.org">nacuc@nacuc.org</a> to make sure your NACUC membership does not lapse.

- Membership in NACUC resides with the credit union, not an individual
- All board members are eligible for discounts on meeting registration fees
- If you are the Board Chair, set up a legacy membership by inviting your Vice Chair (or next in line) to attend NACUC meetings
- Include NACUC's Leadership Development Seminar as part of your Board's succession plan
- Recognizing that some boards rotate positions, NACUC membership transfers to the incoming Board Chair
